**Historical Note:** The Oregon Shakespearean Festival Association was incorporated as a non-profit on August 2, 1937 in the State of Oregon. The original Articles of Incorporation list three officers: Vice-President and Director Angus L. Bowmer, Secretary Frances Hardy, and Treasurer J. W. McCoy. The Articles also state that a President is to be elected at the first meeting, and that the annual meeting is to be held the first Monday in May of each year. The stated intention of the organization, per the Articles, was:

1. To establish, maintain, own, operate, manage and control a theatre or theatres for the presentation of Shakespearean dramas and plays and to produce, exhibit and preserve therein attractions of various kinds and nature, including dramatic, operatic and musical performances, moving pictures, intellectual and instructive

entertainments centered around, about, and concerning the life, works, dramas, and plays of William Shakespeare.

2. To perpetuate the memory and spirit of William Shakespeare and an interest in drama and intellectual matters and affairs.

The stated purpose of the organization in the 1947-amended By-laws was to, "...advance the interest in the writings of William Shakespeare; to provide a vehicle for actual acting participation in Shakespeare plays; and to provide all citizens with an opportunity to enjoy witnessing faithful reproduction of Shakespeare."

Over the years, the By-laws have been amended, and the Endowment Trust Fund created. Committees have come and gone, or their names have changed.

**Scope and Content:** The Board of Directors Records contains five series: COMMITTEES, CORRESPONDENCE, GOVERNANCE DOCUMENTS, MEETING MINUTES, and MEMBERSHIP.

The series COMMITTEES contains the reports and notes of the various committees created by the Board. The committees meet at least once a month. There may be some duplication of reports between the COMMITTEES series and the MEETING MINUTES series, but as they are used in different ways, all have been retained to give a more complete understanding of the workings of the Board. Information contained in the Budget/Finance Committee, Resource Development Committee, and Treasurer files is intertwined with the records of the Endowment Fund Trustees, though the Endowment Fund is a wholly-separate non-profit organization. Committees have formed, renamed or reorganized, and dissolved over the 74-year history of the Board.

The series CORRESPONDENCE includes letters written by the Board President, as well as by the Executive Director of OSF. Much of it pertains to parking issues with the City of Ashland.

The GOVERNANCE DOCUMENTS series includes the Articles of Incorporation, By-laws, Committee descriptions, Festival Mission Statements, Policies, and Trademarks and Registration materials. The MEETING MINUTES series includes the Association annual meeting minutes and the Board meeting minutes. The Association annual meeting is held in March. Over the years, the number of Board meetings has changed. It is currently quarterly. This series also contains a card file that summarizes Board motions from 1951-1958 and 1977-1981. Each meeting folder may contain a meeting agenda, committee reports, reports from external bodies such as the Tudor Guild and Endowment Trustees, budget and finance presentations, lists of committee members and Board nominees, sample marketing documents, production schedules. The 1937-1941 file contains a mix of materials (minutes, tax files, employment documents, membership lists), and includes material related to the 1940 season and subsequent decisions to suspend the Festival for both economic and war-related reasons. The MEMBERSHIP series contains documents listing Board members and officers since incorporation, along with their biographical information which was used in publications and on voting slates. Also included are copies of information given to new Board members.

The set of records is not complete. The Lithia Theatre fire of 1952 destroyed many OSF records. For many years OSF did not have centralized offices, and some materials may have been lost or misplaced. Some records may be contained in the Executive Director records, which are unprocessed. It is unknown how much of the record series may still be in active use by the Board, as there is no formalized records deposition schedule.
